There are various factors, i.e., communicable diseases, infection in early childhood, early motherhood, inter family or maternal marriages, nutritional deficiencies, inadequate sanitation, insufficient and inaccessible health services etc., caused by disability. Most of these disabled persons are very poor and could not afford even to meet their daily living standards. In these circumstances, these are not taken proper care by their household members. Because of disability, these vulnerable people have to face much hardship to depend upon others for their support needs. Particularly, during natural curls, these disabled people suffer a lot since having no sanitary facilities in their living spaces. They have to depend on others for attending their nature calls to occupy them to out of the village, which has become more burden to the other members in the household. has been belongs to a poor scheduled caste family. Unfortunately, in 2012 he got paralysis to his left part of body because of severe brain stroke. Now he has been an intellectually and physically disabled. He has a wife and three children. All these three children got married and living individually with their spouses and children. Present, is living along with his wife in a small semi-permanent house. His wife is daily waged agriculture labourer and had no assets and stable income source for their bread. is unable to control his bladder and bowel functions. As there are no sanitary toilet facilities in the vicinity, he has had to undertake his toileting outside. This never-ending daily drudgery was causing immense despair and stress for him and his wife.

As part of the 'Toilets for Disabled Project', CERDS in September 2015 completed the construction of a sanitary toilet at their house. CERDS provided them construction material as well as hardware material for their toilet cum bathroom on 14.09.2015 and completed it by 30.09.2015. This was possible through the generous sponsorship of HELLO REBOT.

family is now embracing a new future, one where there is equity, privacy and dignity. With twinkling eyes his wife is expressing her sincere gratitude to humanitarian HELLO REBOT for giving the best gift that helped them to build a sanitary toilet facility in their house premises.
