The Irregular monsoons and the recent climate change are the vital reasons for decrease in agricultural productivity. Hence to assume a better living, local residents are forced to migrate or seek employment that is available in various forms. They engage themselves as daily wage labourers with the MGNRE scheme functioning under the Govt. Her mother has to manage the family with the few wages she receives. They avail the rations which are offered at lower rates from the Govt. ration shop.

is studying Class VII in Panchayat Union Middle School, Kiliyanoorpatti. She has an elder brother Tamilselvan studying Grade IX in Govt. Hr.Sec. School, Kannanoorpatti.

As her mother had to take care of the family and moreover less educated, she was unable to assist her children with their school work. Hence she requested the tutor to enroll her daughter in the Evening Study Centre (ESC) tuition class functioning in their own village. She is one of our Evening Study Centre (ESC) students for the past three years.

At the onset she was irregular to the tuition classes. She used to skip her class tests and was very playful in her studies. She had difficulties in English and carried very poor attitude and behaviour. Later, on observing the interest of her fellow mates in the tuition class, she changed her behaviour. Now she is regular to the tuition class and has shown much improvement in her studies especially in Maths and English. Above all, she is now well disciplined and has become a very obedient girl. She is regular with her class tests and completes her homework on time.

Considering her family situation and her interest in studies, she was extended the Educational material support from SPPD. With this support she is able to go to school without any complexity in her mind.

Impact

Children who merit special attention under this support are children orphaned by HIV/AIDS and children who come from a very poor background. Most of the children under this support have not known the usage of slippers, denied of their basic educational materials like school bag, stationery and moreover have developed inferior complexity in their minds.

With this support, they have started to wear slippers, safeguard their educational materials, dress neatly and moreover they tend to orient more towards learning goals and improvise their skills. They are able to go to school without any complexity in their minds and this will empower their self-confidence to improve their lives.
