In a society torn by inequality and injustice, Sahaara seeks to draw out and create avenues for the fulfilment of the dream that is in the hearts of the underprivileged.

Towards this cause, Sahaara works among people as diverse as visually challenged men and women, children in observation / children's homes, slum communities, prisoners and ex-prisoners, orphans, women trapped in sex work and their children. With this vision of 'Gifting Dreams', Sahaara interacts with above 5000 helpless and marginalised people every year.

About Mahima Home:

Every year in Mumbai, thousands of children are left to fend for themselves as they live off the street. They are vulnerable and thus open to acts of physical violence and abuse. The streets are a tough place to grow up in. Mahima Children's Home was started in July 1999 with just two boys, when Sahaara saw the need to shelter homeless and desolate street children. Orphans and children whose parents are unable to look after them find a place at Mahima Home. Holistic development is provided to these children through a home environment wherein dedicated care-givers take care of them.

Today, the home is a haven for 13 boys, all either orphans or with terminally ill parents or children of trafficked women who are unable to care for them. Mahima provides these children with more than just their basic needs. These boys are educated at an English medium school. To enhance their health and physical stature, they are provided four meals a day – breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks during the day. At Mahima, we believe in an all-round growth for the child in order to make their dreams a reality.
