The OPD charges are free of cost and further treatment is done depending on the economic status of the patient. Dr. Rajendra is drawing monthly Gross salary of Rs. 110000/-. The salary was verified from the accounts department. visited the pediatric ward and met with Nirma Garasia, 3 yrs old & Bibla Garasia, 4 yrs old, who were admitted recently and the treatment was free of cost.
