She is been working last 6 yrs as Balsakhi. She works part time and conducts home visits 3-4 days in a week and as per need depending on the condition of the children. She provides care for children from age group of New born to 5 yrs. She is maintaining a register which carries individual records of children under care and a growth chart. She has also been received training regarding taking care of babies and how to follow necessary medical care during initial stages. Children are monitored regularly as per the progress of growth chart. If the medical condition seems critical or needs higher treatment the children are referred to government hospital located at chikla, 15 kms far from the village. Sita Devi receives a monthly honorarium of Rs. 2500/-.	Atish
