He went there with his son and screened by Dr. Punit Kumar. He was prescribed spectacles which were provided free of cost on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2011.

During his follow up examination after one week he was found with good vision and much satisfied as he could once again, capable to attend his labour work. He is especially thankful to the generous donor who made it possible for him to get spectacles.
